Background



○ Purpose

- Increase familiarity with the IUCN Management Categories and Governance Types.



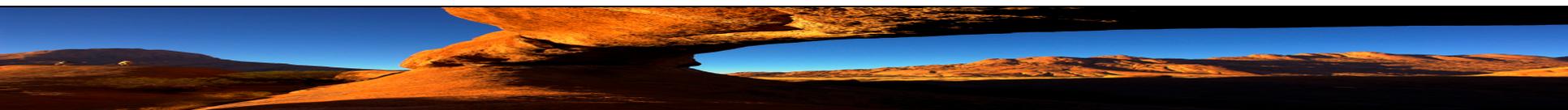
